

The Edward C. Grace Memorial Harbor will be open to the public May 15th at 8:00 AM, unless we are told otherwise by the Governor. As we prepare to open, and especially once we open, you are asked to please respect social distancing with fellow boaters and harbor employees while at the facility.

As of today, we are allowing boaters to place their boats into their seasonal slips. We will follow the same rules that we have followed for years. The only difference is that we will encourage social distancing by delivery companies and seasonal boaters until further notice.

You should also be aware that all facilities will remain closed at least until we officially open. This includes the bath house, pavilion, day room and BBQ areas. Additionally, electricity and water for the slips will not be operational until may 15th , nor will we be doing pump outs until the Harbor officially opens. There will also be restricted access to the fuel dock and office, which will likely remain in place even after we open.

By establishing these guidelines, we continue to take the steps to safeguard physical health, safety, and to protect our workers, boaters and their families.

We will notify you of any changes as we move closer to May 15th. Thank you for your patience.
